Cutting And Patching

Recommendations:

In all cases, cutting and patching should be the financial responsibility of the trade contractor whose work required the cutting and patching. All patching shall be performed by qualified mechanics experienced in the specialty involved, to the standards of the project specifications.

Comments:

These recommendations should be noted on the PME drawing as well as in the supplemental conditions.

This recommendation is the result of considerable discussion and deliberation by the Architect and General Contractor members of the Joint Cooperative Committee of AIA North Carolina and the Carolinas AGC. While its provisions are not binding on individual Architects or General Contractors, the committee believes that adherence to the recommendations will benefit the Owner and the Construction Industry in general.
